### Millennium Equestrian Summer Series

## Rules & Regulations

This is an AEF (Alberta Equestrian Federation) sanctioned show and therefore ALL competitors must provide proof of membership at each show. Annual memberships can be purchased online at [www.albertaequestrian.com](http://www.albertaequestrian.com)

Management committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any errors or make alterations that may be necessary in the prize list. The management committee reserves the right to remove any groom, trainer, owner, manager, or rider from the tournament without compensation. Any acts of discourtesy, or disobedience to the judges or officials by the owner, rider, manager, trainer or groom shall disqualify them from further competition in the tournament and the owner shall forfeit all fees.

Inhumane treatment of a horse including polling, or other abuse will not be tolerated. Violation of this rule will result in immediate disqualification, and forfeiture of the fees. In the case of disqualification, the horse winning the succeeding prize shall receive the prize of the disqualified horse and the other prizes will be adjusted accordingly.

Courses will be posted by the ring minimum half an hour prior to the start of each class.

An approved hard hat with a properly secured and fastened harness is compulsory for all competitors while mounted anywhere on the tournament grounds.

Horses shall be allowed to compete "Hors Concours" with permission from the management. Hors Concours entries will be charged regular entry fees.

Anyone exhibiting dangerous or unsportsmanlike behavior may, at the discretion of the tournament committee, be expelled from the grounds and forfeit fees.

School horses may be entered more than once in the same class or division.

### Add/Scratch Policy

Adds and scratches will be allowed on the day of competition for competitors entered in the show before the deadline. Adds must complete an add slip at the show office and take a copy to the in gate and CANNOT be done solely at the in gate. Scratches MUST be made before the division start and there will be a \$5 scratch fee for each class scratched the day of competition.

## Refunds

Exhibitors cancelling their entries before the closing date will be issued a refund in full. After the closing date of entries but prior to the start of the tournament, shall, upon presentation of a valid veterinarian certificate, forfeit their stall and office fees, all other fees will be refunded. Non-veterinarian scratches will NOT be refunded after the closing date.

## Liability

Millennium Equestrian Ltd, management, tournament committee, nor any of its staff or agents shall in any way be liable for any accident, injury, damage, loss or for any other matter that may happen to exhibitors, competitors, owners, or members of their families, or their agents or to anyone on the grounds, or for any other loss, claim, matter, circumstances or event whatever, in connection with or arising out of, or attributable to, the tournament or any journey to or from the tournament. It is understood that under no circumstances shall the owner, management, Millennium Equestrian Ltd., tournament committee, nor any of its staff or agents be liable for any loss, damages, claims or costs as a result of negligence, and that you agree to indemnify and save harmless Millennium Equestrian Ltd., management, tournament committee, any of its staff or agents from and against any and all liability arising out of any such loss, damages, claims or costs.

## Stabling

All stabling is extremely limited and will be allotted with preference given to out of town competitors. Stabling is \$45/day, providing one horse per stall. No horse shall be placed in a stall that has not been paid for. Initial bedding is included and additional bedding may be purchased. Stabling is available Friday afternoon after 12 pm until one hour after completion of the last class. Please indicate your expected check in date when reserving stabling. **Stabling must be paid for and reserved in advance and there will be NO refunds after closing date. ## Warm Up & Arena's

Warm up area will be held in the indoor sand arena (180x80) and will be open for warm-up prior to each division. Warm up arena will be open for hacking as per schedule but will be limited to 10 riders in the arena at one time. Competition will be held in the outdoor sand arena (120 x 220) weather dependent. Warm Up and Competition will be held indoors and schedule adjusted accordingly in the case of inclement weather. **Exhibitors are not allowed to lunge or ride outside of scheduled hacking or warm-up times.**

## Pets

All dogs must be on leash at all times while on property and must be under control of a responsible individual at all times. Management reserves the right to request your dog be removed from the property at any time.

## Prizes

Ribbons will be awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place in all classes. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded for each division.

Stake Classes will be divided as follows for both Hunter and Jumper Classes:

1<sup>st</sup> – 100% of Listed Class Value (as per prize list)

2<sup>nd</sup> – Refund of Stake Class Entry Fee

3<sup>rd</sup> – Refund of ½ Stake Class Entry Fee

\*\*\*Stake classes will be required to have a minimum of 5 entries per class to run. Full refund will be returned for stake class entry if class cancelled.

## Millennium Equestrian Junior Rider Contest

A total of three (3) exhibitors will be randomly chosen as winners of the Millennium Equestrian Junior Rider Contest. Winners will receive a credit for three (3) ribbon classes (excluding Stake Classes). In order to qualify for this prize, exhibitors must meet the following criteria:

Exhibitor entry must be submitted before closing date

Exhibitor must be entered in a minimum of 3 ribbon classes

Exhibitor must be under the age of 18 years old

Exhibitor cannot be entered in Hunter classes 2'9 or higher

Exhibitor cannot be entered in Jumper classes 0.9m or higher

## Scheduled Schooling Times & Passes

30 minute schooling times may be booked for Friday afternoon and evening from 3:00 – 7:00 and must be booked and paid for in advance. No refunds will be issued for missed school passes.

There will be a limit of 6 horses in the arena for each schooling time scheduled and will be allotted on a first come first serve basis. No horse and rider may enter the arena without a schooling pass. Trainers are asked to book students together and confirm schooling times via email at [mountainviewclassic@gmail.com](mailto:mountainviewclassic@gmail.com). **Schooling sessions will be limited to 30 minutes for \$15/horse and rider combo. A schedule will be posted prior to confirm scheduled times.**
